His Excellency, Professor, Dr. Cyril Kenrick Hunte, is the High Commissioner of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana to the Republic of South Africa and is also the Non-Resident High Commissioner to the Republic of Namibia, High Commissioner of the Republic of Zambia, and Non-Resident Ambassador to the Republic of Zimbabwe.

His Excellency is a full Professor of Economics (on leave) from the Department of Economics at Howard University, Washington, D.C., where he was Director of Graduate Studies in the Department. He was an Adjunct Professor at Johns Hopkins University, Bowie State University, and a Lecturer at the University of Guyana. He holds a Ph.D. in Economics from The Ohio State University, USA.

His Excellency has published scholarly articles in peer-reviewed journals, book chapters, and letters to the Editors on various issues; as well as participated in radio and television discussion programs; and conducted consultancies in India and the Caribbean for the World Bank and the Food and Agriculture Organization. In Guyana, he was the Chief Executive Officer/Director of the Guyana Development Bank (GAIBANK).
